After installation, a ground check and general inspection of the transmission line are conducted and test data, observations, and documentation are provided.

Typical Activities

1. Meet with customer and their vendors to determine scope of work
2. Provide detailed and documented results of these inspections
3. Maintain records of all field inspections

- Transmitter equipment room plans*
- Site plans as appropriate*
